Tim Reynolds is a singer/songwriter/guitarist from New York. His music is diverse with styles ranging from blues, folk, rock, ska, and punk.

In 1994 Tim settled in Atlanta, GA and formed an all acoustic band called Indra's Web. After a year of playing the regional circuit the band went into the studio to record a CD entitled "Good Life Goin". The music is driven by powerful song writing with meaningful lyrics and tasteful guitars that combines rock, blues, bluegrass, and folk elements.

In 1995, Tim formed the band Trinity Project in Boulder, CO. This band offered an explosive set of live originals. While deeply rooted in traditional rock and roll, Trinity Project served up original rock tunes flavored with blues, jazz, metal, and alternative sounds. The band played the regional circuit and opened for bands such as Zuba at the Fox Theater. In the beginning of 1999 Trinity Project recorded a 11 song demo at Fourth Stage Studios in Boulder.

In the summer of 1999 Tim moved to San Francisco, CA. He performs regularly as a solo acoustic artist at venues such as The Cannery, Tip Top Inn, and Broadway Studios. He has also recently performed in other California cities such as Santa Monica, San Rafael, and Modesto.
